

KPC COMPETITION TEAM WELCOME PACKAGE

Welcome to the KPC Competition Team!

We're thrilled to welcome you and your dancer to the 2025–26 Competition Team at Kamloops Performance Company. This package outlines the expectations, commitments, and financial responsibilities associated with the competitive dance program, so you're informed and confident going into registration.

Key Dates

- In-Person Registration Days: June 23–25, after rehearsals (staff will be available an extra hour to assist with registration).
- Registration Opens Online: June 10, 2025 Registration Fee:
 - Waived if registered by June 25
 - \$30 registration fee applies after June 25

BONUS - If you register by June 25th you will be entered into a draw to save ½ of your costume fees.

Program Expectations

Being part of the Competition Team requires a high level of dedication from both dancers and their families. Our shared goal is to provide a supportive, professional, and growth-focused experience for every performer.

What's Expected of Dancers and Family:

- Positive, respectful behavior and communication from both dancers and parents.
- Commitment to team goals, including punctuality, preparedness, and full participation.
- Timely responses to studio emails or communications via our app.
- Participation in fundraising efforts if applicable.
- Dancers must remain in good standing to be eligible for solos/duos or specialty numbers.
 - What does good standing mean: regular attendance, knows choreography, all fees (tuition, costumes, comp) are paid up to date, and being a positive team player.

Attendance:

- Consistent class attendance is expected.
- Absences must be approved in advance.
- Attendance at all competitions your team is registered for.
- Attendance to all rehearsals which may take place on weekends or outside your regular schedule.

Competition Guidelines:

KPC participates in 4–5 competitions per season, including our In-House Competition. Some will require travel throughout the Okanagan Interior and the Lower Mainland.

- Junior Team: Kamloops + In-House
- Pre-Inter and Up: All competitions.
- Adults: Discussed in class

Dates will be released as they become available from the competitions.

Class Requirements for Competitive Dancers:

Program	Required Classes
Company	Ballet and Jazz Tech
Competitive Jazz or Lyrical	Ballet and Jazz Tech
All other genres	None however Ballet and Jazz Tech are highly recommended

Fee Expectations

Monthly Tuition:

- Billed monthly starting August 25, 2025 for September classes.
- All families must register for automatic monthly payments.

Costume Fees:

• Costume rental fee will be charged on November 15, 2025 Per class/dancer (amounts TBD at final costume selection)

Competition Fees:

- Competition fees vary per from \$15-60/dance or \$25-\$125/solo.
- Commercial competitions generally cost more but are typically shorter, resulting in less time missed from school/work.

Fees will be split into two equal payments, charged on the following dates:

Payment 1 50%: Nov. 1, 2025Payment 2 50%: Feb. 1, 2026

Discounts & Incentives:

- Cumulative Class Discount:
 - Each additional class receives a 2.5% discount up to 25% off.
- Competitive Dancer Discount:
 - Additional 10% off required classes for competitive and company dancers.
- Family Discount:
 - Families where each child is enrolled in 3 or more classes will receive an additional 10% discount on tuition.
- Free Tap Class:
 - o Free for students new to tap who are enrolled in 2 or more classes!
- Free Mobility Class:
 - o Free 30 minute mobility class open to all KPC students Youth and Adult
